Dear Dr. Sarkar:

Dr. Larry Walker has been keeping me apprised of your recent communications, including his June 19, 2014 letter to you explaining that in light of the public and unresolved questions regarding your research record, the University of Mississippi cannot go forward with an employment relationship with you and your group. Dr. Walker also informed me that in your June 23, 2014 email to him, you suggested that because you have previously received communications signed by me and others, a letter from Dr. Walker alone was "not enough" to communicate the University's position on the matter.

As the Chancellor of the University of Mississippi, I write this letter to confirm that Dr. Walker's letter to you accurately describes the University's position. You will not begin employment at the University of Mississippi beginning August 1, 2014. As reflected below, I am providing copies of this letter to all of those mentioned in your June 23, 2014 email so you may be certain that all are informed about this matter and concur.

We all had high hopes for our relationship, but the University of Mississippi is not in a position to resolve the many concerns that have surfaced in recent weeks. The current circumstances leave us no choice.
