Hi All,

I just reread Dr Rao's emails from before. He was pretty clear that he did not do the DC experiments. However, the issue is who fraudulently created the new figure via photoshop or some other image editing program. We can send him more pointed email questions, but I would obviously prefer to see his reactions and demeanor via Skype. I am still not sure this will make much of a difference in our decisions. Both will deny, yet both had opportunity and motive. Both kept poor records or have incomplete records. The fact that Rao would not reply clearly until after he had a chance to see his lab book with its lack of record could also be seen as a flag.

I say fine, no Skype and we just weigh the evidence and attitudes before us. There is no real smoking gun here, because the evidence trail is too thin. Clearly fraud occurred. At this point we can only identify who had motive and opportunity. The fact that a second figure made by Dr Rao in the paper also had duplications/errors does not speak well of his rigor either.

I vote we have a meeting next week early and start drafting our findings.
