As your paper was not accepted by us for publication, we do not have any responsibility for complaining about intellectual property violation. That would appear to be the responsibility of Wiley. However, we would draw your attention to the fact that one of the reviewers who evaluated the manuscript for us is also one of the authors who successfully published the article in Systems Research, and if the article turned out to be stolen from the original authors.

We checked this manuscript carefully in our system and have to inform you that Davood Ghorbanzadeh (first author of the Wiley article) was a reviewer of both of the versions of this manuscript done for IDV. He was the reviewer who recommended that it shold be rejected in the second round.

The abstract of the publication in Wiley is very similar to the second version of the manuscript that was reviewed in IDV. But we can't access the full text to evaluate it further.

We cannot be held accountable for this behavior from reviewers. However, we can provide proof that Ghorbanzadeh reviewed this manuscript for us. It seems to us that Wiley should start an investigation with these authors and they might consider sending a complaint to these authors' institutions.
