WHEREAS the Publisher is engaged in providing academic publication services, including assisting authors in publishing their articles in peer-reviewed journals; and WHEREAS the Client seeks to collaborate with the Publisher for the publication of academic papers in Scopus Q2 indexed journals;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

1. Scope of Work

The Acadia Pulse agrees to assist the Client in publishing a total of 400 academic papers in peer-reviewed Scopus Q2 indexed journals.

2. Submission & Processing

- a. The 400 papers will be submitted by the O'Day Al-Owaedi sequentially and in groups, each group consisting of 100 papers.
- b. The Acadia Pulse shall process and manage each batch on a priority basis, according to the order in which the papers are received.
- c. Each group of papers will be handled in accordance with peer-review and publication requirements.



3. Final Acceptance & Publication

- a. The Publisher shall issue final acceptance letters for each paper after successful peer-review and upon receiving confirmation from the respective journal.
- b. Publication timelines will depend on journal processing but will be prioritized based on the order of submission to the Publisher.

4. Obligations of Acadia Pulse

- Ensure all submitted papers are processed professionally and ethically.
- Ensure all publications are within Scopus Q2 indexed journals.
- Maintain transparency and communication with the Client throughout the process.

5. Obligations of the Iraqi Academics Syndicate

- Submit papers in proper format as per journal guidelines.
- Cooperate in providing revisions, author approvals, or additional data if requested by journals.

6. Confidentiality

Both parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of any proprietary or sensitive information exchanged during the course of this agreement.

7. Term & Termination

This agreement will remain in effect until the completion of the project or until terminated in writing by either party with a 30-day notice.

8. Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising from this agreement shall be resolved amicably or, if necessary, through a mutually agreed arbitration process.

9. Governing Law

This contract shall be governed by the laws of the State of Delaware, United States of America.
